Dear friends in Christ of Yellow Medicine Lutheran Church,

The months of summer that I have spent with you have gone quickly! Noel and I have

enjoyed learning to know some of your names and faces, and worshipping with you. We enjoyed the Pioneer Power Threshing Festival and the food stand on August 3rd. We are amazed by the Yellow

Medicine County Agricultural-Machinery Museum! We have enjoyed the way community gathers and the way your care for each other. We expect to grow in faith together. We're baptized, and we encourage one another in this baptized life.

In baptism, parents promise to participate with their children and teach them the ways of this covenant life with God. Children and youth learn of the faith in worship with people across generations. We learn from each other. Other paths of learning are Sunday School and Confirmation, leading up to the rite of Confirmation where young people promise to continue to live in the covenant God made with them in baptism. New Members agree to join the rest of the congregation that is welcoming them in living out this covenant life.

What does this covenant that God made with us in holy baptism life look like as we live it out? Here is language that we as ELCA Lutherans use:

- to live among God's faithful people,
- to hear the word of God and share in the Lord's supper,
- to proclaim the good news of God in Christ through word and deed,
- to serve all people, following the example of Jesus,
- and to strive for justice and peace in all the earth?

To live among God's faithful people includes being in relationship with our siblings in Christ in our daily lives and being with them whenever we can! Regular worship attendance is just the start. It is in <u>worship</u> that we hear the word of God read and preached and where we are given food for the journey through the sacrament of Holy Communion. We are sent from worship into our daily lives to be a witness to the good news that know about Jesus in our actions, our words, our relationships and our work. Doing honest and good work in daily life is a way to serve God too! Where would God's world be without nurses, teachers, famers, bankers, day care providers, grounds keepers, parents of children, faithful spouses and everything in between! What you do in daily life matters, and if you do it in the attitude of living out your baptismal covenant, it gives glory to God!

Serving all people following the example of Christ may seem intimidating. Christ served even to the point of giving his life. I can't/am not interested in doing that! Take the example of Jesus washing his disciples' feet, and then ask yourself "How can I be a humble servant

Striving for justice and peace in all the earth is also a really high bar. We can start by working for justice and striving for peace in our relationships right here where we are and moving out from there. Just remember that all the earth is exactly where God needs justice and peace. Start somewhere!

Thanks, dear siblings in Christ, for boldly living out the covenant God made with vou in baptism.





News from the Church Wide Assembly of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America.

Yehiel Curry, bishop of the Metropolitan Chicago Synod was elected as the 5th presiding bishop.

When Yehiel Curry was elected to serve as the fifth presiding bishop of the ELCA, *Living Lutheran* content editor John Potter sat down with him to talk about his passions, priorities and vision for the church.



"Before he became a pastor, then a bishop, then the chair of the

Conference of Bishops, and now presiding bishop-elect, he was a social worker, then a teacher, then in sales. 'I went from being a social worker to a teacher in the same community where I was helping those families, and in both cases, what I learned is passion is very important. And if you can align a person's passion with a need, then it doesn't feel like work sometimes.

"'It wasn't until I was in the church that I said, 'I could do this for the rest of my life."

We pray that God will bless Bishop Curry's leadership, and that we as the congregation of Yellow Medicine Lutheran Church may continue our vital role as one member of the whole body of Christ,

here and around the world.

- Meeting was called to order by Chairperson Kevin.
- Devotions were led by Kevin.
- Agenda was approved.
- Secretary's Minutes were reviewed and approved.
- Treasurer's Report was reviewed and approved.
- Terri provided an update from the Cemetery Committee. There are 11 vacant lots left for sale in the
 East Cemetery, sections A/B/C/D. There are 104 lots owned by an R.M. Roslid for whom we have no
 contact information. Lot pricing is \$100 for church members, \$200 for non-members for a 4x16 foot
 plot, which is much lower than some neighboring areas (for example, Echo is \$1000/lot). The
 committee would like to start plotting more of the land on north edge so that it is ready to be sold.
- Committee Reports: Parish Ed no updates. Stewardship no updates. Worship will be meeting in the next week. P & M no updates.
- 8. Pastor Sarah provided a Report. There was a baptism at YMLC this month. Pastor has been visiting members in the community. She assisted with working at the food stand and enjoyed the Threshing Show experience and the museum. She and her husband, Noel, have been attending events in the community and getting to know people. Worship schedule is in place; Tim & Gwen will alternate preaching one Sunday/month. Other churches are using online directories or apps called "Instant Church Directory".
- Reviewed results of letters sent to inactive members. Low response rate. Will send one more letter before removing non-contributing and/or non-responsive members.
- 10. Food Stand preliminary results: profit \$5,500. Thanks to all who helped organize, volunteer, and support! Will do it again next year.
- 11. Discussed moving YMLC service time from 10:30 AM to 11:00 AM to allow the Pastor more time to greet people after GFLC service rather than having to rush out during the last hymn.
- Next meeting will be on <u>Sunday</u>. <u>September 14th at 10:15 AM</u> prior to Worship service.
- Adjourned with the Lord's Prayer.
