GUIDELINES FOR SERVING FUNERALS

YMLC WELCA will follow Synod Guidelines.

When notified of a funeral at Yellow Medicine Lutheran Church, Angie Thostenson (507) 766-0909 will call the service team chairs and will notify the service team via email. Service team chairpersons will take calls for dessert or bars.

The co-chairs will call each person on their team, asking for donations for cake, bars or cookies, and giving the team information on when to set up for the funeral (such as the night before, or early the day of), and what time workers should arrive to help the day of the funeral.

**REMEMBER:

CO-CHAIRS KEEP TRACK OF FOOD DONATIONS RECEIVED FROM MEMBERS AND RECORDS THEM IN THE NOTEBOOK. THE NOTEBOOK IS LOCATED IN THE CHURCH KITCHEN BY THE STOVES IN A BASKET.

IF YOU CANNOT WORK, PLEASE TRY TO FIND SOMEONE TO TAKE YOUR PLACE.

IF YOU CANNOT BRING FOOD, PLEASE DONATE \$10 TO "YMLC WELCA" TO HELP WITH COSTS.

FOOD DONATIONS: If the family prefers, they may arrange to have hot dishes and salads catered in.

GUIDELINES FOR SERVING FUNERALS (Cont.)

The two names on each list heading are co-chairpersons. After they serve, these two names go to the bottom of the list, and the next two women become the co-chairs. (Angie helps keep track of this.)

Angie will tell you the time of the funeral, whether or not the family will provide hot dish and/or salad, how many to expect for lunch, if lunch is to be served before or after mourners return from the cemetery and answer other questions you may have. Doors to church should be opened by 8:00 a.m. Carol Tusberg has a key, if you need to get in before that time.

Co-chairs contact each service group member to help set up and/or serve. Ask for manpower, if needed.

REMEMBER! WELCA members who are not in your serving group will also be calling to see if you need food donations. This is a wonderful tradition! Use the church placemats, paper plates, glass cups, and put donated wooden crosses on the tables for centerpieces.

<u>CO-CHAIRS:</u> Keep track of who donated food. Put that list in the funeral book located in the basket by the stoves in the kitchen. This book is a useful resource on how much food is used.

Please check in cupboard for map and table set up and other instructions.

DINING ROOM SET UP FOR FUNERAL SERVING

Reserve tables for the family and pallbearers, using "family" markers. **Everyone will be served buffet style.** Funeral hostesses will welcome and seat people.

Serving tables are to be set up in basement hallway at bottom of stairs.
