Pastor Ponderings

Happy New Year, 2026!

When you read this we will be somewhere in the **12 days of Christmas** which begin on December 25 and continue until January 5th. So don't take down your Christmas tree yet!

January 6th is the day of **The Epiphany of our Lord**, which commemorates the visit of the Magi, or the Wiseman. What? They weren't there at Christmas? Well, probably not. The new star appeared in the sky when Jesus was born. For them to follow the star from "the east", probably from Persia, (what we now know as Iran) indicates a journey of many long months. But they came! *Their visit means that this baby was for everybody!*

The wise men's visit created a stir. King Herod was a jealous man, and did not like the sound of another king. He was determined to eliminate any rival. He ordered every child under two years old and younger in and around Jerusalem to be killed. (The Massacre of the Infants Matthew 2:16-18) Jesus was born into a dangerous and violent world, not unlike our own. *As we go into this new year, how can we be peacemakers in our relationships, our community, and in our world?* Let us take counsel from the Apostle Paul:

Let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus... who emptied himself... being found in human form, he humbled himself and became obedient the point of death – even death on a cross.








Quilting starts January 13th at 9:00 am, with a potluck lunch at 10:00. All are welcome! If you have any questions please get in touch with Connie Velde.

1. Meeting called to order by Chairperson Kevin.
2. Devotions led by Rich.
3. Agenda was approved.
4. Secretary's Minutes were approved.
5. Treasurer's Report was approved.
6. No Committee Reports.
7. Pastor Sarah's Report was reviewed. Correction: name should be read Angela Harris (not Angela Davis).
8. Old Business
 - Thanksgiving Eve service November 26 at 7:00p. Proceeding will be a catered meal at 6:15p. GFLC members are invited to attend both. Deadline for signing up is Wednesday, Nov 19th.
 - Beginning November through February on the 1st Sunday of each month, Worship services and Potluck will be held in the Fellowship Hall. Please arrive early if you can help set up (make coffee, set out plates, forks, napkins, tables, etc.).
 - Zoom Business Membership for YMLC. Currently we have the Pro version. We pay \$159.90 per year. Uses for Bible Study, Worship committee and Annual meeting. Council voted to continue this for another year.
 - Narthex entrance cement is all done! By Eric Soine. Will get a bid for next spring to replace outside sidewalks. Discussed responsibilities of church vs. city in this regard.
9. New Business
 - Children's Christmas Play at YMLC will be Sunday, December 14th.
 - Christmas Cantata will be Sunday, December 21st at 11 AM at YMLC.
 - Sunday Offerings: Will be placed underneath door after collecting. Usher will use pouch with key to put it in the bank. Rich will count on Mondays with assistance of bank staff.
 - 2026 Nominating Committee – Reviewed which positions need to be filled: Kevin's term expiring (will have done 6 years – three 2-year terms). Vonne may run for another term (currently ending 2nd term = 4th year). Rich is in the beginning of his 3rd term (5th year). Tom Oftedahl's term will be up for Cemetery Board. Kevin plans to replace Al Torke's position there. Carol Engel's Memorial committee term will be up (needs to be replaced). Julie Volstad's Worship committee term is up (may be re-elected). Connie Velde term up on Parish ed committee. Judy Enger & Britanna Torke terms will be up on Stewardship committee and will need to be re-elected (no limit). Currently there are 5 ushers (Kevin to contact).
 - Will start working on 2026 budget next month and finalize the second Wednesday in January. Angie will put together an estimate for next Council meeting.
